Glossary of Terms

Audit Tuition - a sum of money charged per non-credit course for any person who is not over the age of 65

Comprehensive Fee - a fee that enhances and supports the student activities budget as well as additional student services such as the Wellness Center.

Food (Commuter) - a sum of money that may or may not be directly billed to a student and is based on the average cost of the commuter meal plan options

Food (Residential) - a sum of money charged for the most comprehensive meal plan offered to students

Graduation Fee - a sum of money charged to a student who completes the graduation application/requirements needed to complete program of study to support graduation activities, diploma and transcript printing

Housing (Commuter) - a sum of money that is not directly billed to a student but is estimated as part of a student's financial aid budget

Housing (Residential) - a sum of money charged for a student living in on-campus housing

Music Lesson Fee - a sum of money charged per individual music lesson instruction

Part-Time Tuition - a sum of money charged on a per credit hour bases for teaching or instruction of a course (students taking less than 12 credit per semester)

Senior Citizen Audit Tuition - a sum of money charged per non-credit course for any adult over the age of 65

Teacher Certification Tuition - a sum of money charged on a per credit hour bases for teaching or instruction of a course for a student who is enrolled in the Teacher Certification Program only

Tuition - a sum of money charged for teaching or instruction of a course(s) based on full-time enrollment for fall and spring terms in an academic year
